Biography

Peter Barnes Martin is a full-time singer-songwriter and jazz musician from Rochester, New York, based out of Monterey, California. His music styling is influenced by the indie folk, alternative and jazz genres and can be compared to artists such as Benny Sings, Kings of Convenience, Iron and Wine, Jack Johnson, Tom Misch, and Chet Baker.
